Introduction

This Website is owned and controlled by Idenfo Ltd. ("we").

We respect the privacy of visitors to our Website, and advise all visitors/surfers and clients to read and understand our Cookie Policy, and to check it periodically for any updates or revisions.

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.

Analytical or performance cookies. These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Functionality cookies. These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

Targeting cookies. These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

When you visit this Website, we may collect personal data about you, either directly (where you are asked to provide the data) or indirectly (through IP address, cookies, etc.). We will, however, use such personal data only for the purposes set forth in this Cookie Policy and we are committed to safeguarding such personal data. This Policy sets out the purposes of our data processing in respect of this Website.

We may gather and analyze information relating to particulars of users, their computing equipment/devices, usage of this Website, including domain name, the number of hits, the pages visited, previous/subsequent sites visited and length of user session.

Purposes of Processing

We collect and process information about customers and visitors to our Website to conduct our business, to inform and offer products and services that may be of interest to you, as well as to compile Web statistics. The information provided by you can be used to contact you when necessary, e.g. to obtain further information or confirmation about your data, notify you about functionality changes to

the Website and our online services, as well as to offer other services that you may find helpful (provided you have not opted out of receiving such services).

Sensitive Data/Information

We do not seek to collect sensitive personal information (such as information revealing personal preferences, political opinions, religious beliefs, health or other matters) through this Website. If we do collect any such data, your prior consent for this will be obtained. Please note that, by providing us with solicited or unsolicited sensitive personal information you consent to our using such personal information as described above.

Disclosure of Information

Where required by Financial Services Regulator(s) or Law Enforcement Agencies, we will share necessary customer and other information, as advised.

Other than this, we will never disclose information that it has collected from our users to any of our affiliates, independent contractors and business partners for any purpose, whatsoever. Also we will not transfer information collected in the process of sales of our products and services.
